GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The applicant shall be responsible for designing, constructing, operating, and maintaining the project in accordance with this CFA, and the implementation agreement requirements as further to be signed between the parties
2. The applicant shall ensure project related installations compliant with all applicable standards, product manuals, interconnection requirements, environmental and all other respective rules and regulations in Georgia
3. The applicant shall not initiate and/or conduct any procurement of goods / services without agreement and consent from the Program. Restrictions may apply on the Country of origin for needed goods and services, that will be communicated in advance by the Program
4. The applicant is responsible for identifying performance requirements and securing all required rights, permits, licenses, approvals, and interconnection agreements from respective state agencies and/or private companies
5. In case of on grid Projects, the applicant shall coordinate with utilities to ensure that the project satisfies all necessary criteria for interconnection of the project to the distribution network
6. Upon substantial completion the applicant shall submit all final certifications and similar documents to the Program (copies are acceptable).
