The Government of Armenia (hereinafter referred to as “the Borrower”) has received a loan from the European Investment Bank – EIB (hereinafter referred to as “the Bank”) – towards the cost of the “Modernization of Bagratashen, Bavra and Gogavan Border Crossing Points of the Republic of Armenia (MBBG BCPs)” Project.
